Dr Fatimata Dia is the Ambassador of Senegal to the United Kingdom since December 2019. From 2014 to 2018, she was the ECOWAS Commissioner for Social Affairs and Gender. Prior to this position, she was the Lead Responsible for Gender Development and Integration at the Millennium Challenge Program, Senegal. From 2010 to 2012, she acted as the Course Director for “Gender and Economics” at the African Institute for Economic Development and Planning (UN), Dakar. Before joining that institute, Mrs Dia served for 11 years as a Researcher at the Senegalese Institute for Agricultural Research.

Dr Dia holds a PhD in Agricultural Economics and Gender from Wageningen University, The Hague, a Doctorate in Veterinary Sciences and Medicine from the University of Dakar, a specialized diploma in Rural Policy and Economics from Université Catholique de Louvain, Belgium, and a PGDip in Feminist Development Economics from the Institute of Social Sciences, The Hague.
