Five key takeaways

- Data security and privacy are mission critical and should be discussed at the most senior levels of the organisation
- Preparation for incidents is key:
 - Incident response plans
 - Tabletop exercises
 - External resource identified and lined up
 - Know your law enforcement contacts
- Consider what disclosures are required to regulators, to customers and to the market in the event of an incident
- Coordinate the response to an incident across all stakeholders, including management, counsel and PR, to ensure consistent messaging
- Don't forget about insider trading risk in the case of major incidents
