Upon graduation, she received the Parker School Recognition of Achievement for the depth of her coursework in international and comparative law.

In addition to her legal practice, Suparna sits on the board of Citizen Physicians, an organization that seeks to train future health care providers in effective civic engagement, and assists with the Washington Leadership Program, a non-partisan organization that
