

## Hogan Lovells secures important victory for Maryland resident taxpayers with out-of-state income from pass-through entities

In an important ruling for taxpayers with out-of-state income, the Maryland high court held Monday that Maryland's refusal to fully credit income taxes paid to other states violates the U.S. Constitution's dormant Commerce Clause.
