

H.E. Ambassador TAREK ADEL

Ambassador TAREK ADEL graduated from the American University in Cairo in 1986 with a BA in Political Science and Economics. He joined The Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1987, and assumed different posts in Egypt's Embassy in Washington, 1989-1993, as well as in the Egyptian Missions to the United Nations in Geneva, 1997-2001, and in New York, 2004-2006.

In Cairo, Ambassador Tarek Adel worked at the Foreign Minister's Cabinet. He was also the Permanent Representative of Egypt to the League of Arab States in Cairo, 2013 – 2015, before being appointed as Assistant Foreign Minister for Arab Affairs, 2015- 2016. He served as Egypt's Ambassador to Greece, 2009-2013, and the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, 2016 - 2018, and is currently Egypt's Ambassador to the United Kingdom since November 2018.

Ambassador Adel received the Grand Cross of the Order of the Phoenix, from H.E. the President of the Hellenic Republic. He is married with two children.
