



# Brexit

## The International Perspective



**86%**

of global respondents think the UK should stay in the EU. 8% think it should leave and 6% don't know.



**90%**

of UK respondents think the UK should stay in the EU. 6% think it should leave and 4% don't know.

Percentage of respondents who want the UK to stay in the EU



**87%**

of small firms



**72%**

of mid-sized firms



**91%**

of large firms



**82%**

said the UK would be less attractive as a location for accessing the EU. 1% said more attractive and 15% said it would stay the same.



**74%**

felt that the UK would have less influence over policy if it left the EU. 3% said it would have more influence and 18% said it would stay the same.



**46%**

of all respondents would reduce investment in the UK if it left the EU. 46% said investment would stay the same. 1% of respondents said they would invest more.



**58%**

of respondents from banking and finance would reduce investment in the UK if it left the EU. 3% would invest more. 36% would stay the same.
